Court Facilitator Program

Court Facilitator

Klickitat County Superior Court employs a Facilitator who may assist you with family law cases. Currently, the program only handles Dissolution cases with or without children.

The Facilitator is not an attorney and cannot give you legal advice. The Facilitator also cannot assist litigants who are represented by an attorney. The Facilitator also **cannot** do your court paperwork **for you**; your document(s) are **your responsibility**. However, the Facilitator can assist you in assuring your paperwork is complete, correct, and ready to be presented to the Court. It is *not required* that you use the Facilitator; it is just an available option.

Scheduling an Appointment & Fees

Until a time to be determined, the Court Facilitator Program is not taking in-person appointments. However, we are taking phone appointments, where the Facilitator can run through your paperwork with you and answer any questions you might have along the process. At this time there is no Facilitator fee; this may change in time. On the county website on the Superior Court page here:
